
NORTH VANCOUVER Paved greenway, quiet streets **7km loop**

The Green Necklace connects North Vancouver city parks in a continuous loop of safe and separated greenways. The route was originally conceived in 1907 and laid out in North Vancouver City's original town plan. Much of the route has been enhanced with art and heritage signs. It's an easy bike ride, walk, or run.

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📍 **START at Norseman Park - 23 St & St Georges North Vancouver**

- 1 SOUTH** St Georges, **RIGHT/W** 22 St, **LEFT** Eastern, **RIGHT/W** 21 St *Sargent Park, Gordon Smith Gallery
- 2 WEST** 21 St *explore Wagg Creek Park
- 3 LEFT/S** Jones *explore Mahon Park trails
- 4 LEFT/E** Keith, **EAST** through Victoria Park
- 5 *ANDREWS ON 8TH - lunch!**
L St. Andrews to 8th, retrace route
- 6 EAST** Keith, **LEFT/N** Grand Boulevard on bike path
- 7 LEFT/W** 19th, **NORTH** on bike path along "The Bench," **LEFT/W** 23 St, back to start
