



## 52 AROUND RICHMOND RICHMOND Hardpacked trails 38km loop



Loop around Richmond's many trails. Ride along the Middle Arm Dyke then follow West Dyke Trail. Circle Garry Point Park for views over the Salish Sea. Visit the historic fishing village of Steveston on the Fraser River and have lunch at Fisherman's Wharf. Meander along the South Dyke Trail, visit the Britannia Shipyards and Finn Slough. Return via Shell and Bridgeport Trails for a full circle tour.

### START at Canada Line Bridge - Richmond



- 1 WEST** River Rd, **LEFT/S** Great Canadian, cross Bridgeport, **SOUTH** Garden City, **RIGHT/W** Capstan
- 2 LEFT/S** Middle Arm Dyke Trail *\*visit Olympic Oval*
- 3** *\*Explore Terra Nova Park trails*, **SOUTH** West Dyke Trail
- 4** *\* Loop around Garry Point Park*, **EAST** on Moncton  
*\*visit Steveston Fisherman's Wharf, Cannery Museum*
- 5 EAST** South Dyke Trail *\*Britannia Shipyard - a must-see!*
- 6 EAST** Westwater then Dyke Rd,  
**EAST** on signed South Dyke Trail - 7km  
*\*visit London Farm, Finn Slough, follow South Dyke Trail - 7km*
- 7 NORTH** Horseshoe Slough trail, **NORTH** Shell Road Trail *past Bridgeport Rd*
- 8 LEFT/W** Bridgeport Trail, choose route:  
a) **RIGHT** VanHorne to Canada Line Bridge  
b) **LEFT** VanHorne, **RIGHT** Great Canadian to Bridgeport Station

#### Optional Routes:

- CRABAPPLE RIDGE:** 7.5km
- RAILWAY GREENWAY:** 8km
- ALTERNATE ROUTE**
