FORT LANGLEY • LANGLEY • ABBOTSFORD *Quiet country roads, some hills* **30km**



In the fall, the valley calls. Pick up a picnic lunch in Fort Langley and head east along River Road. The route starts with a small climb then meanders on quiet country roads east of Historic Fort Langley. You'll see river views, turf farms, a winery, and maybe a cranberry harvest!

📍 **START at Marina Park - north end Church St & River Rd - Fort Langley**

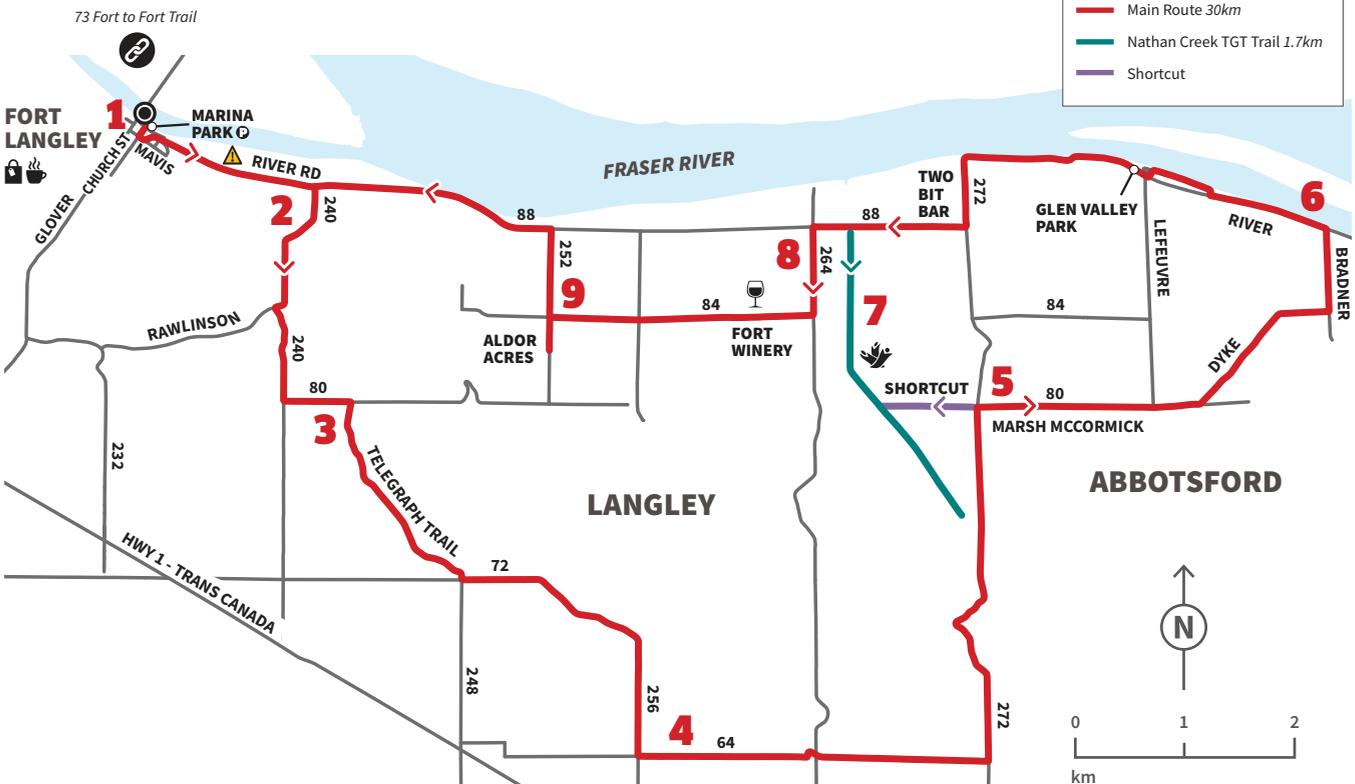
- 1 SOUTH** Church St, **LEFT/E** Mavis, **EAST** River Rd - shared road ⚠️
- 2 RIGHT** 240, at Rawlinson keep **LEFT** on 240, **LEFT/E** 80
- 3 RIGHT/S** Telegraph Trail, **LEFT/E** 72, **RIGHT/S** 256
- 4 LEFT/E** 64, **LEFT/N** 272 - *Wahoo!* downhill
- 5 RIGHT/E** 80 - Marsh McCormick, **LEFT** Dyke, **LEFT/N** Bradner
- 6 LEFT/W** River *picnic Glen Valley Park or Two Bit Bar, **LEFT/S** 272, **RIGHT/W** 88
- 7 *NATHAN CREEK TGT TRAIL 1.5km one way, 3km return:**
SOUTH *explore out + back on trail
- 8 WEST** 88, **LEFT/S** 264, **RIGHT/W** 84 *visit Fort Winery, Aldor Acres
- 9 RIGHT/N** 252, **LEFT/W** 88 becomes River Rd, back to start



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
