



27 FRASER LOOP



BURNABY • VANCOUVER • RICHMOND • NEW WESTMINSTER Trails, bikeways, dykes, shared roads **35km loop**



Explore the shores of the Fraser River on this loop. The route is flat with varied terrain, a mix of easy park trails and bikeways, and busy road sections with no bike lanes. Start in Burnaby from the 22nd Street Skytrain or Marine Drive Skytrain in Vancouver.

FRASER RIVER NORTH • 16km one way


🕒 **START at 22nd St Skytrain - New Westminster**

- 1 WEST** on BC Parkway *or*:
*ROAD ROUTE: S Trapp, R Willard, L 10th
- 2** Just before Southridge overpass, **LEFT/S** steep gravel trail, **SOUTH** 12 Ave, **LEFT** Meadow
- 3** Cross Marine Way, **SOUTH** on Fraser Way, **LEFT** Glenwood, **RIGHT** Trapp, **LEFT** Wiggins, **RIGHT/W** Riverbend
- 4** Enter Terminus Park *explore trails, **WEST** under railway trestle then along Fraser Park Dr
- 5 WEST** Burnaby Foreshore Park, **WEST** on River District trail
- 6** After Gladstone Park - **LEFT/W** along riverside path
- 7** ⚠️ At Argyle **LEFT/W** Kent - busy road no bike lane for 3 blocks, **LEFT/S** Crompton, **RIGHT/W** on Kent Bikeway - parallels street, **RIGHT/N** Ontario, **LEFT/W** Kent - busy road no bike lane for 3 blocks

FRASER RIVER SOUTH • 18km one way

🚆 **FROM MARINE SKYTRAIN SOUTH** Cambie, **RIGHT/W** Kent

- 8 LEFT/S** Ash onto Canada Line Bridge, **LEFT/E** River Rd, **LEFT/N** No. 4 Rd, **RIGHT/E** on dyke trail
- 9 RIGHT/S** No 5 Rd, **LEFT/E** Vulcan, **LEFT/E** No 6 Rd
- 10** Continue **EAST** on River Rd - ⚠️ busy shared road 10km
- 11 LEFT/E** Westminster Hwy, at Boundary cross to north side of highway, **EAST** on Boyd Greenway, cross Howes
- 12** Choose route:
a) **TRAIL:** at Starbucks go **LEFT** on mall bike path, **RIGHT** grassy dyke trail, **RIGHT** Wood, **RIGHT/W** Boyd to west side of **Queensborough Bridge**
b) **ROAD:** **EAST** Boyd bike lane to bridge
