



41 COQUITLAM PARKS

COQUITLAM Shared roads, bike lanes, greenways and park trails **15km - 18km**

Take Evergreen Skytrain line to explore Coquitlam's parks. From Burquitlam Station the route runs through neighbourhoods and parks. Visit the playground and sculpture garden in Blue Mountain Park, circle Como Lake, and ride through the urban forest in Mundy Park. Return via same route or take Coquitlam Crosstown downhill to Town Centre Park and hop on the Skytrain at Lafarge-Douglas station.

📍 **START at Burquitlam Skytrain - Coquitlam**

- 1 EAST** Smith, **RIGHT/S** Fairview, **LEFT/E** Foster
- 2** Cross Blue Mountain, **RIGHT/S** MacIntosh, enter Blue Mountain Park **explore trails, sculptures*
- 3 LEFT** Veterans Trail, **NORTH** Porter, **RIGHT/E** Cottonwood
- 4** Enter Como Lake Park - *circle lake*, at **NE** corner go **EAST** on Regan
- 5 MUNDY PARK 4km loop:** At Wilmot, enter Mundy Park on School Trail, **LEFT** Nitnat Trail, **EAST** Perimeter Trail Choose route **6** or **7**:
- 6 RETURN 7km:** **WEST** Regan, **LEFT/S** Poirier, **RIGHT/W** Winslow, **RIGHT/N** MacIntosh, **LEFT/W** Foster, **RIGHT/N** Fairview, **LEFT/W** Smith to Burquitlam Skytrain
- 7 *TOWN CENTRE PARK 5.5km:** Follow signed **Crosstown Route**: **RIGHT/E** Como Lake Greenway, **EAST** Spuraway, **LEFT** Armada, **RIGHT** Daybreak, **LEFT** Saddle, across Dewdney Trunk, **NORTH** Mariner Way, **NORTH** Johnson, **RIGHT/E** Guildford to Town Centre Park **Lafarge Lake-Douglas Stn*
