**SURREY** Hardpacked park trails, bike lanes on shared roads **4km - 30km**



Three parks in South Surrey offer something for everyone. Beginners can explore Crescent Beach, Elgin Park and Serpentine Fen. More advanced riders can loop the parks together for a 30km ride with views west across Boundary Bay and north to Vancouver's Mountains. There is lots to see along the way...meandering wetland trails, the Nicomekl River, ducks and birds, and a historic farm.

🕒 **START at Blackie Spit Park - Crescent Beach - South Surrey**

**CRESCENT BEACH** • 5km loop then 3km on road one way ●

- 1 Explore Blackie Spit \*ride to point
- 2 WEST along shoreline, SOUTH Crescent Beach Trail, LEFT/E Maple
- 3 RIGHT/E Crescent - busy road with bike lane 3km ⚠️

**ELGIN PARK** • 4km one way • 8km return ●

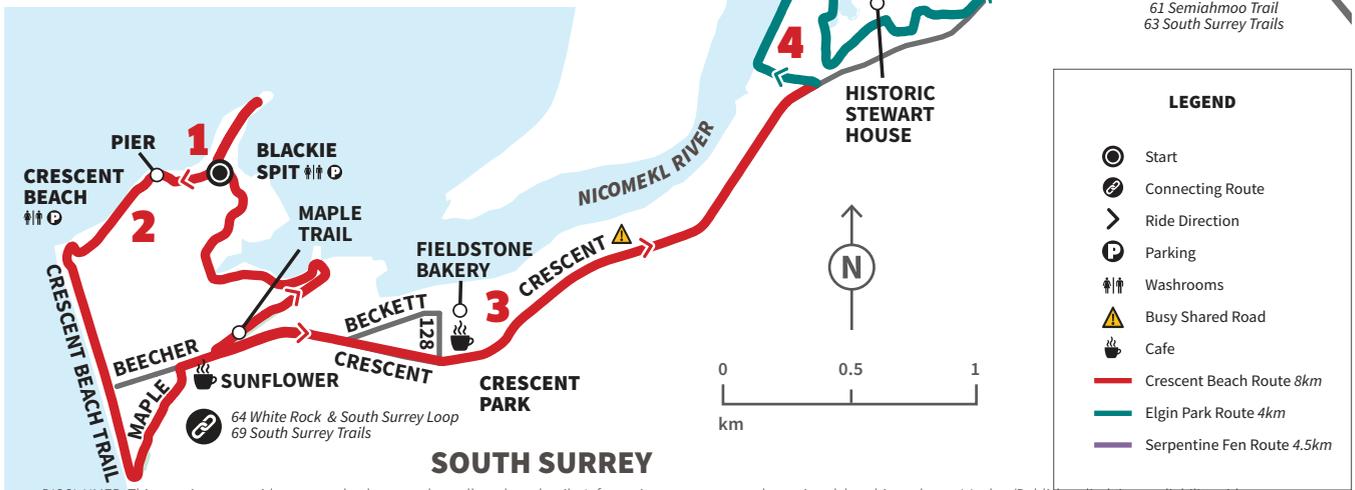
- 4 Follow shoreline trail at Elgin Park \*explore wetland trails and bridges, visit Historic Stewart House
- 5 Continue EAST on Nicomekl River trail

**SERPENTINE FEN** • 4.5km one way • 9km return ■

- 6 LEFT/N Elgin bridge, LEFT/N King George Hwy - busy road with bike lane ⚠️
- 7 Loop Serpentine Fen park, return via same route
