



11 RIDGEWAY LOOP



VANCOUVER *Bikeways, quiet shared roads* **24km loop**

Vancouver's Ridgeway Greenway is a linear exploration of a string of parks, walkways, seating areas, and public art. Look around you as you ride — and look up — there's art everywhere.

☉ **START at Science World - Main Street Skytrain - Vancouver**

- 1 SOUTH** on Seaside Greenway, **LEFT/S** Ontario, **LEFT/E** 1st Ave, follow CVG-Central Valley Greenway
- 2 RIGHT/S** Lakewood Bikeway through John Hendry Park, **EAST** on BCP-BC Parkway to Central Park

☉ **ALTERNATE START at Patterson Skytrain - Burnaby**

- 3 WEST** on BCP **explore Central Park trails*
- 4 WEST** on 45th-Ridgeway Bikeway **art on route*
- 5 RIGHT/N** Nanaimo, **LEFT/W** 38th-Ridgeway Bikeway

6 *MOUNTAIN VIEW CEMETERY 2.5km:

**Explore cemetery, resume WEST on 37th*

7 *QUEEN ELIZABETH PARK 3km:

Just before Columbia **RIGHT** into park, **NORTH** on path to Reservoir Garden - *Bloedel Conservatory, Dancing Waters Fountain, Henry Moore sculpture*

WEST down path **explore park trails, Quarry Garden,* **EAST** on road, emerge on Ontario

8 NORTH on Ontario Bikeway, return to start
