



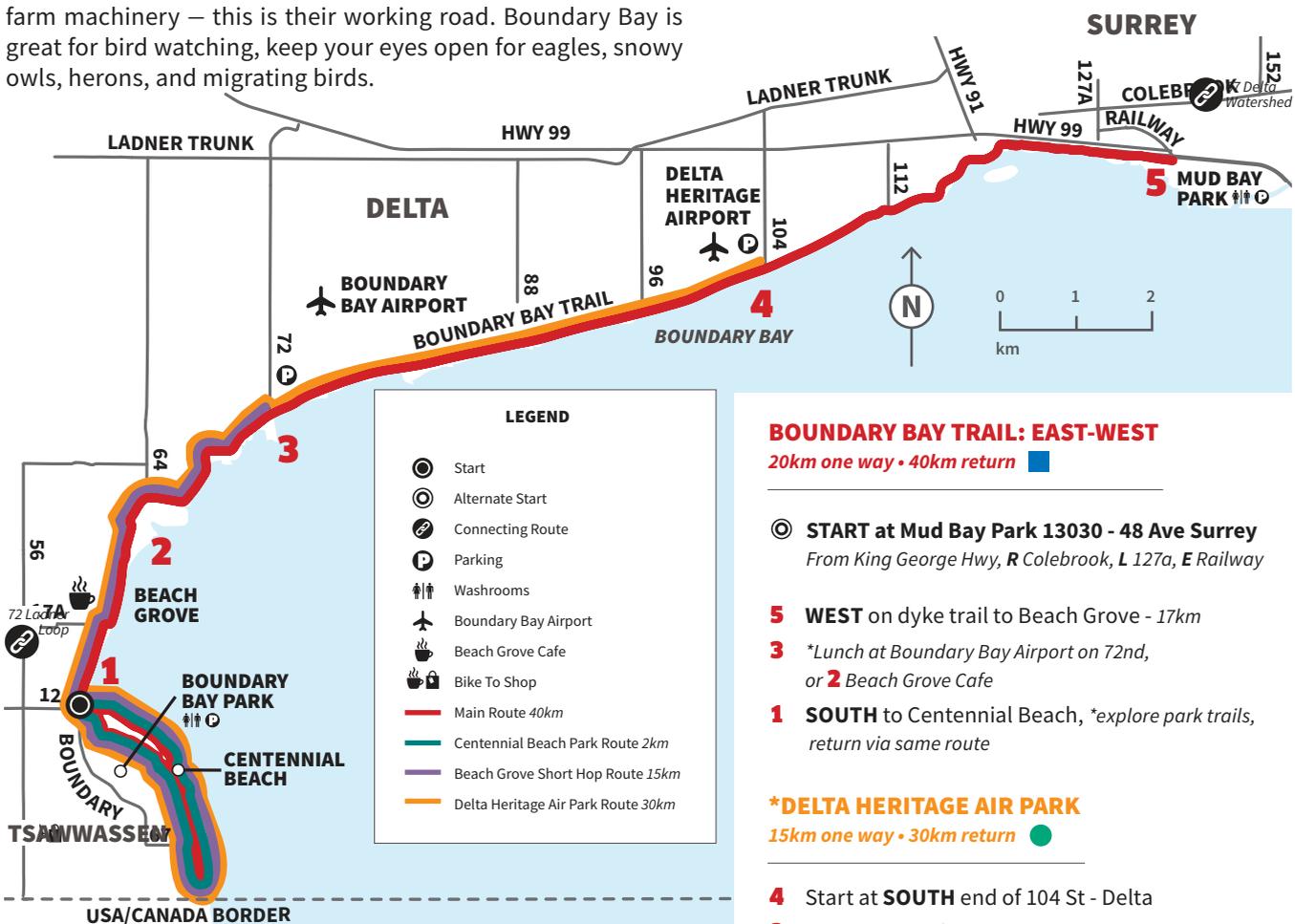
# 66 BOUNDARY BAY TRAIL

**DELTA** Hardpacked dyke trails 15km • 30km • 40km

Boundary Bay Park is a perfect place for beginning riders. There are many ways to enjoy the easy dyke trails. Start anywhere along the route or do the whole thing. Centennial Beach has an easy loop, Boundary Bay dyke trail extends 20km east of Beach Grove – ride them together for a 40km ride. Respect farm machinery – this is their working road. Boundary Bay is great for bird watching, keep your eyes open for eagles, snowy owls, herons, and migrating birds.

## BOUNDARY BAY TRAIL: WEST-EAST

20km one way • 40km return

- **START** at Boundary Bay Park 12th Ave & Boundary Bay Rd - Delta
- 1** \*Explore park nature trails, exit park at 12 Ave, **RIGHT/N** Beach Grove
- 2** **RIGHT/E** at 17a Ave onto dyke trail - shared with farm vehicles
- 3** \*72nd St - Boundary Bay Airport - lunch
- 4** \*Delta Heritage Airport
- 5** Ride **EAST** to Mud Bay Park - 17km, return via same route

## BOUNDARY BAY TRAIL: EAST-WEST

20km one way • 40km return

- **START** at Mud Bay Park 13030 - 48 Ave Surrey  
From King George Hwy, **R** Colebrook, **L** 127a, **E** Railway
- 5** **WEST** on dyke trail to Beach Grove - 17km
- 3** \*Lunch at Boundary Bay Airport on 72nd, or **2** Beach Grove Cafe
- 1** **SOUTH** to Centennial Beach, \*explore park trails, return via same route

## \*DELTA HERITAGE AIR PARK

15km one way • 30km return

- 4** Start at **SOUTH** end of 104 St - Delta
- 2** **WEST** to Beach Grove \*explore Centennial Park trails, return via same route

## \*BEACH GROVE SHORT HOP

7km one way • 15km return

- 3** Start at **SOUTH** end of 72 St - Delta
- 2** Ride **WEST** into Beach Grove  
\*explore Centennial Park trails, return via same route
