



20 BURNABY LAKES & CREEKS

BURNABY • NEW WESTMINSTER

Hardpacked trails, bike lanes, quiet roads **11km - 29km**

Visit Burnaby's two largest lakes on this route. Start at Stony Creek, explore Burnaby Lake and Deer Lake then return via the CVG - Central Valley Greenway along the Brunette River.

BURNABY LAKE • 11km one way • 22km return

START - at North Rd & Jefferson - Coquitlam

- 1 Just north of Jefferson, **SOUTH** on Stony Creek Trail
- 2 **LEFT/E** Beaverbrook *loop through Cameron Park, find dragon at SW corner
- 3 **SOUTH** Noel, **RIGHT/W** Cameron, **LEFT** Keswick, **RIGHT** BMUT - Burnaby Mountain Urban Trail - stay left at trail fork
- 4 **RIGHT/W** Government then Winston
*visit Burnaby Lake Nature House L Piper
- 5 Cross Sperling overpass, **SOUTH** Sperling to Sprott, choose:
 - a) **Return via same route** and make choice at cue 9
 - b) Continue to **DEER LAKE**


DEER LAKE • 7km loop with walk-bike sections

- 6 **RIGHT/W** Sprott, **LEFT/S** Kensington Urban Trail, **LEFT/E** Canada Way, **RIGHT** Deer Lake Ave, enter Deer Lake Park - Shadbolt Center, Burnaby Art Gallery, go towards lake, **RIGHT/W** on first trail, then next **RIGHT/N**
 - 7 **LEFT/W** Price, enter trail, walk boardwalk, **WEST** toward Royal Oak, **SOUTH** on second trail - not boardwalk
*312 STEPS: behind Lookout Tower lock bikes, walk steps
 - 8 **EAST** on trail then Deer Lake Dr, **LEFT** first trail past boat rental, **LEFT** Sperling, **LEFT** Deer Lake Ave
- Retrace route back:** **LEFT** Canada Way, **6 NORTH** Kensington, **RIGHT/E** Sprott, **5 LEFT/N** Sperling, cross overpass, **4 WEST** Winston - CVG Central Valley Greenway

9 At Cariboo choose:

- a) **STONEY CREEK 3km:** return same route
- b) **CENTRAL VALLEY GREENWAY 3.5km:** **RIGHT/S** Cariboo, **LEFT** on CVG along Brunette River, through Hume Park to Braid Station or continue on CVG

FROM BURQUITLAM SKYTRAIN - 1km:
N Clarke, L Como Lake, R Elmwood, L Gardenia, L trail beside #643, R Claremont, L Jefferson, R North Rd
