NEW WESTMINSTER *Bikeways, greenways and quiet shared sheets* 3km - 16 km



Summertime is a great time to head out on the Crosstown Greenway to Queens Park in New Westminister. From 22nd Street Station to Braid Station ride by heritage houses, visit Queens Park, ride the easy Millennium Trail, then explore Sapperton and Hume Park.

☉ **START** at 22nd Street Skytrain - New Westminister

**CROSTOWN GREENWAY** • 10km one way ■

**1** **RIGHT** 7 Ave, cross 20th, **RIGHT** on sidepath, **LEFT** 7 Ave-Crosstown Greenway, follow signed route through Sapperton to Braid Station


☉ or **START** at Queens Park - First St

**QUEENS PARK MILLENNIUM TRAIL** • 3km loop ●

**2** Enter park and ride clockwise on Millennium Trail

**HERITAGE HOUSES** • 3km loop ■

**3** **RIGHT** First St, **LEFT** Regina, **LEFT** 3 St, **RIGHT** 5 Ave, **LEFT** 5 St, **LEFT** 4 Ave, **RIGHT** 4 St, **LEFT** 3 Ave
